

CTT reference format

The following formats and examples are offered as models for references that might appear in the bibliography of a paper. The formats are based on *Rules for Content, Form and Structure of Bibliographic References* (2005). CTT reference format guide is as follow with bibliography examples.

Journal Article Published

Include the issue number in parentheses immediately after the volume number. Give page numbers.

Article in Proceeding or Book

Give publisher and its location. Give year. Include page numbers.

Proceeding, Book, Report, or Thesis

Give publisher and its location. Give year.
